Competition Prompts

1. Level 1

a. Age Eligibility	Level 1 is open to primary students ages 6-7.
b. Prompts	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Informative Speech- The most amazing place in the world is... 2. Persuasive Speech- Teachers should make learning more fun 3. Entertaining Speech- The funniest thing I've ever heard is...
c. Time Regulations	Speeches should be approximately 3 minutes. Speeches should be no shorter than 2 minutes and no longer than 4 minutes.

2. Level 2

a. Age Eligibility	Level 2 is open to primary students ages 8-9.
b. Prompts	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Informative Speech- When I grow up, I want to be... 2. Persuasive Speech- Adults should learn more from children 3. Entertaining Speech- If I could have any superpower, it would be...
c. Time Regulations	Speeches should be approximately 3.5 minutes. Speeches should be no shorter than 2.5 minutes and no longer than 4.5 minutes.

3. Level 3

a. Age Eligibility	Level 1 is open to primary students ages 10-12.
b. Prompts	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Informative Speech- Children can change the world 2. Persuasive Speech- Children should be allowed to choose what they learn in school 3. Entertaining Speech- The best thing about being young is..
c. Time Regulations	Speeches should be approximately 4 minutes. Speeches should be no shorter than 3 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes.

Helpful Hints:

1. Competitors should give their speeches a title.
2. Students do not need to state which prompt they chose. It should be evident in their speech.
3. Speeches should not begin with the prompt.
4. Competitors should imagine they are speaking to a live audience and deliver their speeches accordingly.
